Testimony - Off the couch and onto the treadmill



After my surgery last fall, I developed an infection that led to sepsis and then septic shock. This left me with a disturbing side effect. My heart rate would soar to abnormally high rates as I walked. Rather than setting idle as I prayed for God to bring healing, I started exercising my faith by adding action. Literally putting feet to my Faith. I decided to get off the couch and onto the treadmill as I worked towards getting this under control. While walking on the treadmill, I started speaking to my heart rate. "Heart you must come into alignment with the Word of God. The Word

of God says I'm healed. You must obey the Word of God."

Healing came as I continued walking and declaring healing over my heart. Initially, I had to walk very slow and take frequent breaks to keep my heart rate down from dangerously high levels. After a few weeks, I improved so much that I outlasted the treadmill. I walked longer and farther than that treadmill could handle. The motor overheated and quit on me. We purchased a heavy-duty model that doesn't restrict my rehab. Now, I'm using it every day. I have even run on it. I'm determined to come out of this not just barely squeaking past this, but soaring high like an eagle!

Expanded Reach on the Lower Yukon

Covid-19 mandates and restrictions caused us to scramble to utilize creative methods to continue with the Gospel presence in Alaska Bush Churches. We were able to utilize live streaming in many locations however, a few of our locations do not have adequate Internet to live-stream or for folks to watch. In those technology-challenged villages, we reverted to audioconferencing. This has not only met the



need for the continuation of consistent weekly ministry, but it has also brought an increase in the footprint of our reach. In one location utilizing audio conferencing, they are consistently having folks from surrounding villages join in on the services. We are thankful that BGMC provided funds to purchase specialized electronics. This equipment allows us to run 2 way audio through the microphones and speakers with no ringing, looping, or feedback. *"The call-in services have been a great way to connect people from all over the lower Yukon and western AK with the gospel and Bible teaching. And these services have played a part in preparing a group of believers in Nunam Iqua for a church*

plant. I'm excited to use this JK audio device to continue making these call-in services available for people across the region as we return to in-person services in Emo and Alakanuk". David Huff



New Ministry Launched - Dandelion Kids

A new and exciting ministry is up and running now. US Missionaries Pam and Tracy Hodges wrapped up Itineration and returned to Alaska just in time for travel to shut down because of Covid-19 mandates. This new ministry has the potential to reach hundreds of homes and dozens of new villages in Alaska. They have grown quickly and have already sent out over 5,000 DVDs to 36 remote communities. We have dozens of unreached villages in Alaska, and this is another tool to get the gospel where there is no active ministry taking place. I believe that Dandelion Kids can lead to the establishment of house

churches or church plants. It reaches beyond children's ministry because the adults in the home watching with the kids will be impacted as well.

Alaska Student Partnership

Another very strategic resource we have that opens the door to get the gospel into small villages in Alaska is Missionary School Teachers. This concept has been utilized for many years. Missionaries and pastors have and presently are working as teachers or other professional jobs. This model of missionary school teachers has now been developed and is deployed by Alaska Student Partnership. Team members are being placed in villages this fall as new members start training in Fairbanks.
