The Dr. told me that I can lift whatever I feel like now. During this season, I have continued to use the treadmill and weights to build strength and stamina. Also, at my recent Oncologist appointment, the Dr. reported that my blood is normal and “I don’t need to see you for six months.”

A couple of months after my diagnosis came, he received a diagnosis of stage 4 cancer. We immediately started praying for his healing.
