The greater the battle rages, the greater the grace of God is and the greater the victory.

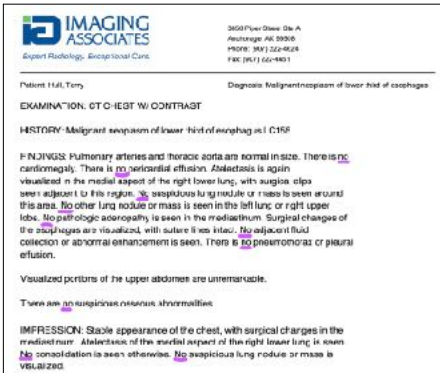
