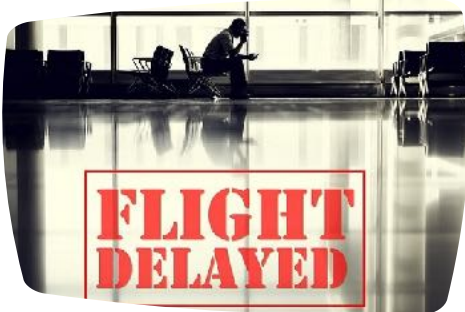

We have experienced a lot of unstable stormy weather this winter, which has caused delays and canceled flights into villages in Alaska.



Recently, I was waiting at the airport on a weather hold for one of my trips. After catching up on calls and returning emails, I put my phone down, enjoyed my coffee, and relaxed.

Then, I noticed an AK Native man walking down the hallway. The Holy Spirit quickened to me that I needed to talk with him. We made eye contact, and he came over to me. He asked, *do you have 3 dollars for a coffee?*

I responded, *sure. After getting the money out of my wallet, I reached it towards him. As he came close to receive it, I asked, you are going to use this for coffee and not alcohol, right?*

He quickly responded, *definitely, I won't* As he lifted his shirt to reveal a bag, he said, *I can't drink; I just got out of the hospital.*

After asking his name, he told me he was Adam from the Bethel area. Then I replied, *I would like to pray with you, Adam. I'm a minister, and I know God wants to touch you today.*

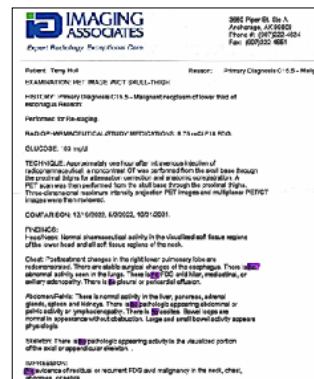
