Chevak Update

Pastor Jimmy Okitkun and I were honored to minister for several days in the village of Chevak, one of our targeted missions sites.

Exciting new doors of ministry opportunities are opening for us in this community.

We are committed to deepening our relationship with local leaders and enhancing our outreach efforts.

Equipment has been ordered, and plans are set to launch live streaming of the weekly church services from Kotlik to Chevak to support and grow this new work.

At the end of May, a small team joined me for a logging expedition along the Yukon River.



After collecting the logs, we returned to the camp, where we winched them out of the water to be processed with our sawmill for use in construction projects.

We are grateful for our volunteers' support and hard work. They built this new building in one week.



This new dormitory, which sleeps 32 in bunk beds, was ready in time for us to use during camp this year.

Plans are underway to build at least three more dorm cabins. All the materials for the next one, which will be built next summer, have been purchased.
