Thanks to hard-working construction teams, we finished the **third boys' dorm cabin** just in time for the first week of camp.



Another crew tackled the building of a **new shower house and storage building**—a last-minute miracle project completed in just five days after the barge finally arrived with supplies.



That same barge also delivered materials for our **fourth dorm cabin**, which we plan to build next summer.
