Update from the Hull's

It was a blessing to reconnect with longtime friends while also building new relationships along the way. Each service provided meaningful opportunities for ministry, and we witnessed many lives touched by the power and presence of the Holy Spirit.



Unexpected Moments

During this season, we experienced several unexpected moments where God moved in powerful and unforgettable ways.

Often, it is in these unplanned moments that God begins extraordinary work.

In one small church of just 22 people, I gave the altar call at the conclusion of the service.

To my surprise, seven individuals responded to the salvation message. That morning became a powerful moment of transformation for those folks.

At another church, during the altar call, a man at the far end of the altar began speaking in tongues.

Although the invitation was not specifically for the baptism in the Holy Spirit, God knew this man's deepest need, and he was baptized in the Holy Spirit that day.



These moments reminded me of Isaiah 43:19 (NIV):

"See, I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up; do you not perceive it? I am making a way in the wilderness and streams in the wasteland."

Isaiah reminds us that God often works through the unexpected. Life can take sudden turns, and we sometimes encounter moments we didn't plan for or anticipate.

Yet, God declares, ***"See, I am doing a new thing!"*** This is a powerful reminder that God is always at work, even when we don't immediately recognize it.

Unexpected Moments (Continued)

Often, we expect God to move in familiar ways, but He frequently chooses new paths, new opportunities, and new seasons.

Sometimes this new thing God is doing begins small—like a seed just breaking through the ground.

If we're not paying attention, we might miss it. Yet, those unexpected moments are the very beginning of something significant.

God also paints a powerful picture: *"I am making a way in the wilderness and streams in the wasteland."*

The wilderness represents uncertainty, while the wasteland speaks of dryness or difficulty. Even in those places, God promises to create paths where none existed and bring refreshment where life once seemed barren.

Unexpected happenings are not interruptions to God's plan — they are part of it.

So when you encounter the unexpected:

- **Stay open to what God is doing**
- **Look for the "new thing" He is creating**
- **Trust Him to make a way, even when you can't see it**
